ABOUT TRI-LAKES HUMANE SOCIETY

Tri-Lakes Humane Society has been saving little lives in the Adirondacks since 1942. We speak for those who can't by educating the public on animal issues and fostering a more humane community. We take in the animals who need us most in our community and provide shelter, nutritious food, medical treatment, daily exercise, and loving care. Tri-Lakes Humane Society is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization. We are a NYS Registered Shelter #RR036.

SERVICES WE OFFER

- Shelter for the unwanted, abused, lost, and homeless animals in the Tri-Lakes area.
- Lost and found services and support to reunite pets with their people.
- Matching adoptable pets with loving new homes.
- Humane Education regarding local and state animal laws, humane animal care, respect for animals, and the value of the human-animal bond.
- Spay/Neuter vouchers for underserved members of our community to offset the cost of the spay/neuter procedure and make it more accessible.
- Low-cost spay/neuter and vaccine clinic for cats in partnership with FARVets (began in November of 2021) to ensure underserved households can access affordable spay/neuter and vaccine services.
- Animal Control services for the Village of Saranac Lake, Town of Harrietstown, Town of Brighton, Town of St. Armand, Town of Franklin, and Town of Santa Clara.
- Pet Food Pantry to assist community members when times are hard and ensure everyone in the family has a full bowl.



QUICK FACTS

- Tri-Lakes Humane Society is a no-kill shelter, which means we never euthanize animals for space or because finding their right fit proves to take more time.
- We are one of the few shelters in the Adirondacks and sole shelter provider for a large area, including four counties: Franklin, Essex, Clinton, & Hamilton. Under contract with local towns & villages, we provide both shelter & dog control services for communities in our area.
- Tri-Lakes Humane Society receives no funding from the national Humane Society of the Unites States (HSUS) or New York State. 83% of our funding comes from private donors, businesses, grants, events, and shelter services.
- Every animal adopted from us is vaccinated, microchipped, and spayed/neutered prior to adoption.
- Tri-Lakes Humane Society assists hundreds of animals each year. In 2021, we took in 198 animals, adopted out 154 cats and dogs, reunited 60 dogs and cats with their families, 147 animals were spayed/neutered while in our care, 111 spay/neuter vouchers were issued to underserved pet owners in our community, and 19 cats were vaccinated and spayed/neutered at our low cost clinic in partnership with FARVets.
